ABOUT THE COURSE

This new BA (Hons) Architecture course has been developed in close consultation with the architecture profession and is complemented by a network of practitioners and industry representatives to ensure students are equipped with professionally relevant skills.

The focus of the course is an exploration of new architecture relevant for the 21st century. Students explore how good design can benefit from a detailed knowledge of materials and examine both traditional and new ways of constructing architecture.

There are opportunities to use the wide range of facilities at NUCA and for collaboration with other students of Art, Design and Media. Understanding historical and contemporary connections between art, design and architecture plays a key part in the curriculum and gives students an opportunity to contextualise their practice within an international, national and regional framework.
